

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Sealed proposals will be received by the Governing Body of Leavenworth, Kansas at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall Leavenworth Kansas until 3:00 PM on the 16th day of December 2020 for the construction of Project No. 2020-938 "4th & Olive - Alley CDBG Sanitary Sewer Project" which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall 100 N 5th Street Leavenworth, Kansas. Due to COVID-19 there will be no in person bid opening. Anyone wanting to attend the bid opening can do so virtually. To attend virtually contact the Office of the City Clerk at 913-682-9201 for call in instructions. Bids must be submitted on forms attached to and made a part of the contract documents. Ensure that you comply with all provisions regarding Affirmative Action, Bid Bonds, Non-Collusion Affidavit, and other bidding conditions. Plans, specifications and other contract documents are on file in the Office of the City Clerk and are open for public inspection. Bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the office of the City Clerk of Leavenworth, Kansas. Name of the bidder and "Project No. 2020-938" shall be clearly written on the envelope. Copies of the contract documents, plans and specifications may be obtained from Drexel Technologies, Inc, 10840 W. 86th Street, Lenexa, KS, 913-371-4430. Checks are to be made out to Drexel Technologies in the amount of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00). Plans and specifications may also be purchased on a disk for Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) based on the payment method above. This is a non-refundable fee. There will be a mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting at 3:00 pm on the 9th day of December 2020 at Wollman Park Shelter House at 1300 Shawnee Street, Leavenworth, KS. All contractors wishing to bid are required to attend the Pre-Bid Meeting. We are unable to hold this large of a gathering at city hall due to COVID-19. We realize that this is an outside meeting, under a roof, but the project site doesn't have ample parking. A certified check, cashier's check or acceptable bid bond must accompany all bids for not less than 5% of the amount of the bid. All bids must be accompanied with a copy of the "City of Leavenworth Affirmative Action Program Approval Letter" issued from the City Manager's Office and the signed/notarized Non-Collusion Affidavit. The Governing Body of the City of Leavenworth, Kansas reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities.
