

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS Sealed proposals will be received by the Governing Body of Leavenworth, Kansas at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Leavenworth, Kansas until 10:00am on Tuesday, July 19, 2023 for the Riverfront Community Center Asphalt Shingle Replacement Project No. 2023-RCCROOF at which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall, 100 N. 5th Street, Leavenworth, Kansas 66048. Bids must be written/typed and submitted on forms attached to and made a part of the contract documents. Ensure that you comply with all provisions regarding Affirmative Action, Non-Collusion Affidavit, Bid Bonds and other bidding conditions. Note the successful bidder will be required to submit a (2) two year maintenance bond as outlined in section VII of this document.

Bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the office of the City Clerk, 100 N. Fifth, Leavenworth, KS 66048. Name of the bidder and Riverfront Community Center Asphalt Shingle Replacement, Bid No. 2023-RCCROOF, shall be clearly written on the envelope. There will be a Non-Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting at 10:00am on Thursday, July 6, 2023 at the Riverfront Community Center, 123 S. Esplanade Street, Leavenworth, Kansas, 66048. All contractors wishing to bid are encouraged to attend the Pre-bid Meeting.
