

The City of Leavenworth Kansas Engineering Division Notice to Contractors Request For Bids City of Leavenworth Water Pollution Control Laboratory Air Handler Replacement Project No. 2019-904 The City of Leavenworth will receive bids for the proposed work at the office of the City Clerk 100 N 5<sup>th</sup> St in Leavenworth Kansas until 3:00 pm on March 6 2019 from all HVAC contractors for the construction of Project No. 2019-904 "Water Pollution Control Laboratory Air Handler Replacement Project" which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Hall 100 N 5<sup>th</sup> St Leavenworth Kansas. Bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the office of the City Clerk of Leavenworth Kansas. Name of the bidder and "Project No. 2019-904" shall be clearly written on the envelope. Bids must be submitted on forms attached to and made a part of the contract documents. Bid and contract documents are on file in the Office of the City Clerk and are open for public inspection. Copies of the bid and contract documents may be obtained from Drexel Technologies, Inc, 10840 W. 86<sup>th</sup> Street, Lenexa, KS, 913-371-4430 at "NO CHARGE" to the contractor. All HVAC contractors desiring to be considered shall be required to comply with the City's Affirmative Action and Equal Employment Opportunities requirements. In order to verify compliance all firms considering this project and not in possession of a valid Certificate of Compliance issued by the City Manager's Office must complete and submit the City's Questionnaire on Personnel Practices for our review. Firms found in compliance with the City's AA/EEO requirements will be issued a Certificate of Compliance. To be considered all firms MUST submit a copy of the "Affirmative Action Approval Letter" from the City Manager's Office and the Non-Collusion Affidavit with the bid. A certified check, cashier's check or acceptable bid bond must accompany all bids for not less than 5% of the amount of the bid. Contractor is required to comply with all provisions regarding Affirmative Action, Non-Collusion Affidavit, Bid Bonds and other bidding conditions. There are no MBE/WBE requirements on this project and Davis Bacon Wages do not apply. All work will be funded by the City of Leavenworth and will be a tax exempt project.
