Background:

The City contracts with O'Neill Events and Marketing for the production of the annual City festival, Camp Leavenworth. After a great start to the new event in 2019, staff from the City and O'Neill started planning the 2020 festival in early 2020. As with nearly every aspect of public life in 2020, the plans for Camp Leavenworth were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. To have a festival similar to the 2019 event, decisions and contracts would have started in early spring. With the uncertainly created by COVID-19 it was determined that repeating the festival in the same form as 2019 would be impossible in 2020. However, Keli O'Neill Wenzel and Jenna Smith from O'Neill Events and Marketing proposed a different event designed to capture the spirit of Camp Leavenworth, to be done in a safe way, to bring the community together and to attempt to maintain some of the momentum created by Camp Leavenworth in 2019.
