ISSUE:

Receive an update on the Bird Scooters pilot project.

BACKGROUND:

Bird Scooters began a 12-month pilot project after the City approved the MOU in April 2022. The City simultaneously released an informational electric scooter webpage. Since that time, over 3,600 rides have occurred with total mileage of 5,248. Bird Scooters has provided use and complaint statistics to assist with the continued assessment of the pilot program. In addition, the City has access to daily data on scooter use, including heat maps showing where most rides begin and end within municipal boundaries. Staff will present a comprehensive update regarding scooter use.

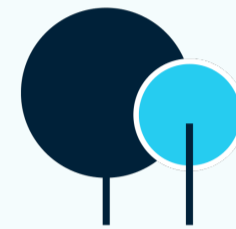
