CITY COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING

The City Commission met for a Study Session with the following members present: Mayor Mark Preisinger, Mayor Pro-Tem Jermaine Wilson, Commissioners Nancy Bauder and Larry Dedeke. Commissioner Myron J. (Mike) Griswold attended via telephone.

The Governing Body signed the consent for the special meeting written waiver notice.

Mayor Preisinger called for a motion to open the special meeting.

Commissioner Dedeke moved to open a Special Meeting. Commissioner Bauder seconded the motion and was unanimously approved. The Mayor declared the motion carried 5-0.

Consider the Purchase of 301 Delaware Street—City Manager Paul Kramer presented for consideration the purchase of 301 Delaware Street from Triple R Properties LLC in the amount of \$52,500.00 which includes the price of the property and realtor commission fees. Mr. Kramer discussed various properties that have been purchased in the past to spur economic development. If the Commission approves the purchase Staff will move forward with demolition and regrading of the site.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve the purchase of 301 Delaware Street from Triple R. Properties LLC in the amount of \$52,500.00 and authorize the Mayor to execute all documents related to the purchase. Commissioner Bauder seconded the motion and was unanimously approved. The Mayor declared the motion carried 5-0.
