**BURN PERMIT REGULATIONS** 

### **BI-ANNUAL BRUSH BURNING**

The Leavenworth Fire Department allows for the bi-annual burning of brush and tree debris during the spring and fall. Leaves are not included and cannot be burned.

Spring burning dates: Fall burning dates: <u>April 1<sup>st</sup>- May 15<sup>th</sup></u> October 1<sup>st</sup> -November 15<sup>th</sup>

## TO REQUEST A PERMIT TO BURN: <u>913-758-2980</u>

REQUESTS ARE RECEIVED DURING THE FOLLOWING HOURS:

- Monday Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- Saturday Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

### Conditional requirements for bi-annual burn permit:

• Date, exact location and responsible person(s)

Safety measures shall include:

- <u>Wind</u> Burning shall be prohibited and all issued permits <u>voided</u> when sustained wind speeds are in excess of 10 mph.
- 2. <u>Supervision</u> The permit holder shall ensure the burning is constantly supervised until extinguished.
- Extinguishing Equipment Approved onsite fire extinguishing equipment or materials, such as a garden hose, water truck, extinguishers or other equipment as approved by the Fire Chief shall be on hand for immediate utilization.

\*\*Any burning that is in violation or deviation from the burning conditions and requirements shall be extinguished and the permit revoked. \*\*

### REGULATIONS THAT MUST BE FOLLOWED TO ALLOW BURNING UNDER PERMIT ISSUED:

- A. Applicants for permit must be in legal control of the lot or parcel of land on which burning is to be done.
- B. Debris piles to be burned shall be no larger than 6' in diameter and 4' in height.
- C. No burning shall be done within 50' of any structure or on the right of way or easement of or under any overhead lines.
- D. A garden hose and water supply or other fire extinguishing equipment as approved by the Chief or the Chief's designee shall be on hand.
- E. There shall be no burning of tires, asphalt, roofing materials, or any other material that upon combustion may produce toxic smoke.
- F. Fire shall be constantly attended by a competent person and shall be completely extinguished before being left alone.
- G. Fire shall not be kindled or accelerated with any petroleum products (e.g. gasoline, kerosene, diesel fuel, charcoal lighter).
- H. No fire shall be kindled, under permit or otherwise, which in burning causes or creates a dense smoke or offensive odor.
- I. All burning matter shall be extinguished by 6:00 p.m. or sunset; whichever occurs first.
