QUALIFICATIONS

- Be at least 18 years of age at time of appointment
- Graduation from a high school or GED equivalent
- Posses a valid driver's license at time of appointment
- Firefighter I & II Certification at time of application
- Valid KS Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Cert
- Current Fire Service Entrance Exam (FSEE) within the last 24 months with a score of 70% or greater
- Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification taken within the last 12 months
- Ability to pass physical examination including drug screen, and oral interview

TRAINING

Firefighters are trained for technical rescues, suppressing fires, public education and daily hands on training. Firefighters attend and participate in formal and phased intensive training and instruction sessions in firefighting methods, first aid, and other fire department activities. They participate in the department's physical fitness program.

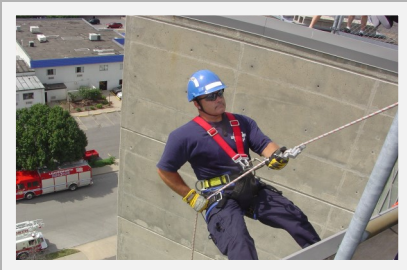
