- Must swim 300 yards non-stop using front crawl and breaststroke.
- Must tread water for two minutes with no hands.
- Must retrieve a 10-pound brick from 9 feet of water.
- Must be 15 years of age or older.

Class Information:

Student must attend all classes in each session to become certified. Class time is from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. Class will be a mix of online instructional modules and in-person meetings.

Cost is \$180 for residents/\$200 for non-residents.
