
## **Park History**

In 2007, a small group of volunteers who believed in a dream started to raise the money needed to build the park. Eventually, \$30,000 was donated from area citizens, memorials, and fundraising events. On September 25, 2010, the City opened the Waggin' Tails Dog Park.



The six-acre fenced dog park is located at the northeast corner of the Veterans Administration (VA) Park. The park features grassy knolls divided into two areas. Watering stations are provided on both sides for owners and their canine companions. Portable restroom facility is available. Memorial Benches and Legacy Trees are placed throughout the park.

# Waggin' Tails Dog Park **Rules & Regulations**

- Dog owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their animals.
- All dogs attending the park must comply with required vaccinations and other posted rules and regulations.
- Owners are required to pick up their dogs' waste at all times.
- Animals are to be kept on a leash while entering and exiting the park.
- A leash should be carried at all times.
- Children are to be supervised at all times and not left to roam the park alone.
- Animals known to be aggressive or vicious may not enter the park.
- ₩ Non-neutered males are to be closely supervised.
- Dogs in heat are not to enter the park.
- Dogs may NEVER be left unattended.
- No food, glass containers, alcohol, children's toys or sports equipment are allowed.
- No smoking or vaping on park property.
