Waggin' Tales Dog Park Rules and Regulations

The following Code of Conduct has been established to provide for the safety of park patrons and their pets, as well as for the protection of park resources:

Dog Owners

- Are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries or damage caused by their dog(s).
- Are responsible to see that their dog(s) are healthy, current with all veterinarian recommended vaccinations, and have proof of a current rabies vaccination. (May be required upon request.) Tags may serve as proof.
- Are required to pick-up and dispose of their dog's waste in the collection containers provided to help reduce the potential spread of parasites.
- Must be kept on a leash while entering and exiting the park.
- Must have leashes readily available at all times.
- Must leash and remove their dogs(s) from the off-leash area at the first sign of aggressive behavior.
- Must closely supervise their dog(s) and have them in view at all times.
- Must not bring food, dog treats, glass containers, alcohol, children's toys, or sports equipment into the off-leash area.
- Must not allow children under the age of 16 within the boundaries of the off-leash area unless accompanied by an adult.
- Must closely monitor non-neutered male dogs.

Dogs

- Known to be aggressive or vicious are not allowed in the park.
- May NOT wear pronged, spiked or choke collars within the off-leash area.
- Under the age of 16-weeks of age are not allowed in the area.
- In heat are not allowed anywhere in the park area.

Assumption of Risk:

All those entering the designated off-leash area, are aware that the dogs are un-leashed and loose. Despite the best efforts of any dog owner/handler, a dog may act in an unpredictable manner. Dog owners/handlers are entirely responsible for their dog's actions and accept the risk of allowing their dog(s) to interact with people, other dogs, employees and their vehicles in the performance of their duties. Owners are legally responsible for any injury caused by their dog(s).
