


Total new cases year to date 2020: 1167

As of March 16 City Hall was closed to the public due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Code enforcement was advised to just address minor case and observe re-inspections until such time that the public would be able to address violation without violating state, county, and local laws. March 23, our department reduced the number of staff that would be present in the office and field at a given time. April 27 our department proceed to full staff, and proceed with minor code enforcement cases.
