Miscellaneous Staff Musings

Pertinent Current Issues related to the Rate Study. These are all open to discussion with the selected firm.

- 1. Depreciation Expectations shown below, and include some allowance for inflation:
 - Buildings are 15-30 years
 - Improvements other than buildings are 15-30 years
 - Machinery and Equipment are 5-15 years (with a few exceptions that may be less than 5 years-computer equipment-and a few items that may be 20 years)
 - Infrastructure are 15-30 years
- 2. Bond/Interest Payments are approximately \$750,000 per year trending down to \$265,000 and expiring in 2032.
- 3. In the face of no rate study the city will increase rates at approximately 3% per year in any case.
- 4. General plant improvements from wear and tear as well as scheduled replacement of key equipment about \$200,000/year.
- 5. Collection System Emergency Repairs \$100,000 per year
- 6. Assumes no increase in Stormwater Allocation as there will surely be a Stormwater Utility created within this time!
- 7. Assumes no significant staff level increases
- 8. CIP (Capital Improvement Projects) Collection System I/I focus is currently about \$500,000 per year; needs to double now to \$1,000,000 and increase to \$1.5 Million within 10 years.
- 9. City co-bills sewer and refuse fees (and potentially stormwater fees) with Leavenworth Waterworks (not a city department). This relationship is subject to change, but is not expected to change for at least several years.
- 10. CIP items not related to plant or I/I = \$1,500,000 in the next ten years, including:
 - a. Bank Stabilization project from WPC building upstream to Marion Street \$350,000.
 - b. Replacement of at least one Trickling Filter media \$100,000.
 - c. Some level of UV bulb replacement \$100,000.
 - d. Implementation/Installation of SCADA (remote monitoring and operation, etc.) system at WWTP (Wastewater Treatment Plant) \$250,000.
 - e. Some studies to facilitate expansion into (to be) annexed areas \$100,000.
 - f. Expansion of a trunk sewer line somewhere to the southwest, west or north \$350,000.
 - g. Etc.
